

# The New E-Z Knocking Pen brings new convenience and safety to the small slaughter house.

## Here is the simple and safe procedure

The animal enters rear of pen in the usual way, and, seeing light at the other end, tries to walk through.

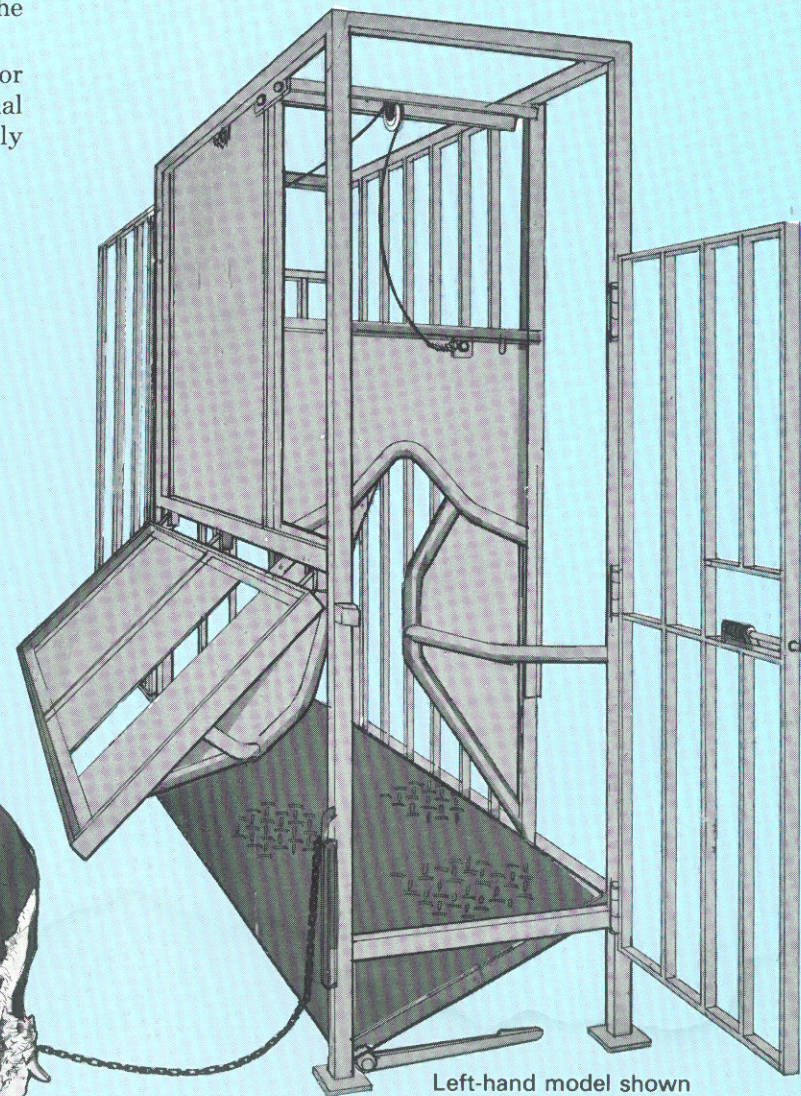
When he puts his head through the restrainer, the operator lowers the top portion of the restrainer which automatically locks in place and holds the animal's head securely. Operator then drops the rear gate behind the animal for extra safety.

Moving to the front of the pen the operator opens front gate, stuns the animal with a humane stunner and loops the safety chain around the animal's neck.

Operator then trips the pen to drop the floor and release the side panel as the stunned animal rolls clear of the pen so shank can be easily shackled.

Notice that the animal is still tied securely by the chain around his neck to prevent his getting up and charging if improperly stunned. This eliminates the need for a fence around the dry landing area.

The E-Z Knocking Pen is sturdily built for long, hard use. The structure is hot dip galvanized after fabrication and all crevices are sealed for easy cleaning. Also available in stainless steel.

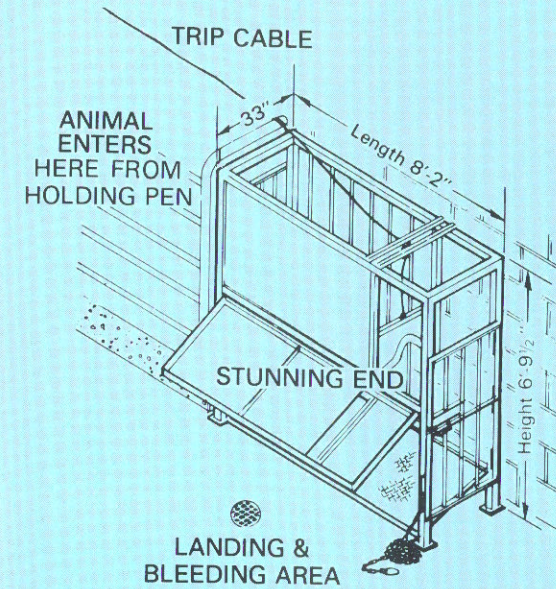
